

# The basics of a homely set?

Although officially aimed at the hospitality, leisure and hotel industries, the columns and cubes would be equally at home in the kind of homely live stage set which has come into vogue over the past few years.

translucent polyethylene, the units are claimed to be unbreakable (i.e. roadworthy), with each independently-controlled unit utilising a single light source which can be set at one colour or to morph through a sequence of colour changes.

Items can be displayed directly on top of the lamps to absorb the illumination and colour. Alternatively, the lights can be capped with acrylic or metal to achieve a different effect.
